



COURT ATTIRE FOR CANDIDATES FOR ADMISSION TO THE BAR AND COUNSEL MOVING AT GROUP ADMISSION CEREMONIES

Candidates for admission and their counsel moving have the option of wearing traditional Court attire (wigs, bands, white shirt and gowns) or gowns over neat clothing. Neat clothing means dark suit, white shirt, and tie for men and equivalent dress for women.

So long as the Judges continue to wear ceremonial robes at admission ceremonies, they prefer that candidates and counsel moving who have access to traditional Court attire should wear it.

Applicants and counsel moving may *not* combine the two options by, for example, wearing a wig and a tie, or bands over a tie.

Applicants are requested to remind their counsel moving of these requirements.
