



### **Vacancy for FLS co-regional representative in Auckland Central - expressions of interest sought**

The FLS executive is seeking expressions of interest from members for the role of co-regional representative for Auckland Central.

The regional representative role is an important link between FLS members and the executive. You are the face in your local area, along with any local member of the executive. The regional representative is expected to cover the following roles.

Organise ideally three events in your area per year including:

- an educational event
- a social/networking function
- a Section dinner of local family lawyers/bench

Keep the executive informed by:

- seeking membership on your local family law committee and/or case management meetings and sending minutes of those meetings to the manager
- raising any local issues of importance with the executive for consideration
- advising the manager of your upcoming local events

Keep your local members informed by:

- sending regular emails and/or holding regular meetings with members
- introducing yourself to new members when they join either by phone, email or in person

- building a list of local non-lawyer contacts (e.g. local CYFS staff, Police contacts) and supplying these to local members
- maintaining contact with other regional representatives to share ideas and discuss local issues

Keep the wider membership informed by providing a brief article with photos on your local activities for the *Family Advocate*.
