Our plan is to minimise staff at our sites and eliminate people coming to our sites.

LEVEL 4 -ELIMINATE

Likely that disease is not contained

- Sustained and intensive transmission
- Widespread outbreaks

LEVEL 3 - RESTRICT

Heightened risk that disease is not contained

- Community transmission occurring OR
- Multiple clusters break out

LEVEL 2 - REDUCE

Disease is contained, but risks of community transmission growing

- High risk of importing COVID-19 OR
- Uptick in imported cases OR
- Uptick in household transmission OR
- Single or isolated cluster outbreak

ACTIVITY TO STOP

- Physical reporting to offices
- All community work
- All community programmes
- Breaches that relate to conditions only
- Managing low risk cases
- Alcohol and drug testing

ACTIVITY TO MAINTAIN

- Public safety breaches
- All reports to NZPB and PAC
- EM installs and deinstalls
- Visits to people who depend on us such as HD or restricted to residence
- Residential facilities and supported accommodation

ACTIVITY TO START

- Phone reporting for all cases and new starts
- Phone screening for addresses we must visit
- PAC reports over the phone
- Working remotely wherever possible
- Local monitoring of staff safety app

- Undertaking safe visits guide
- Access to phone support services guide
- Access to essential support guide
- We are an essential service, we will continue operating with care and consideration.
- Some people are dependant on us we need to look after them.
